

Ellis developed a method of weaving resist warp and weft threads directly into the cloth and shared her findings in her breakthrough book. My copy arrived today and I am thrilled with it. My brain is on fire with new ideas. The directions are clear but are intended for someone who has done a bit of weaving already. There are both 4-shaft and 8-shaft loom directions. The section on natural dyeing is quite interesting, even for someone

like me who isn't into natural dyes.

Building on the information in the first edition, this revision includes more information on use of natural dyes in woven shibori. Catherine's instructions for shibori and dyeing are clear, comprehensive and pretty much the only place where you will find this information. Her first edition went out of print and was difficult to find. So pleased that it has been re-issued; the additional instructions on natural dyeing, mordant discharge and printing are worth having for themselves. Many wonderful photos of completed work. Worth having in your library.

I love Catherine Ellis books. She is so informative and she has included more information on natural dyeing than the last book.
