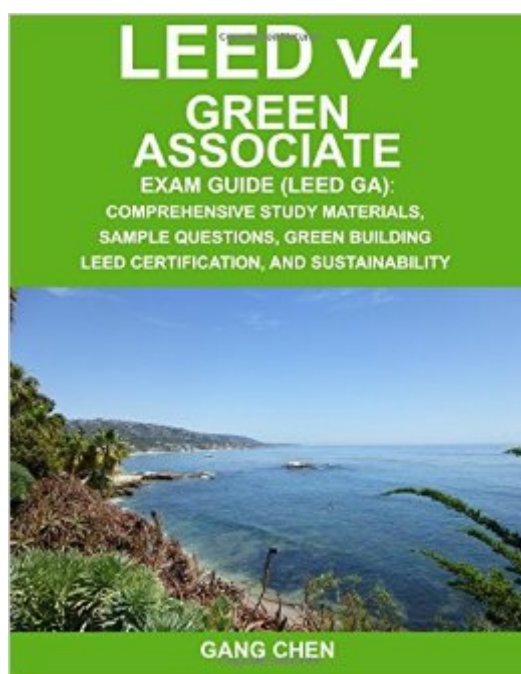

This book was not what I expected. Seeing the numerous 5 star reviews, I expected more. The reality is that this book does not (in my opinion) present the LEED Green Associate exam information in a clear manner, and may not contain all information needed to pass the test. Worried I would not pass the test studying this material alone, I bought practice tests and a study guide (for \$10 more than this book for the tests and study guide together) from Green Building Education Services. In my opinion, there is no comparison between the two. I am returning this product by Gang Chen for a refund. With improvement, I think it could be a very useful guideâ |but it needs work. I found errors that could have been fixed by a novice editor. For example, the title has "LEED GA" on it, but USGBC explicitly says never to use the term "LEED GA", but instead use "LEED Green Associate" or "LEED Green Assoc."â |and that's on the cover of the book! For what it's worth, I passed the Green Associate exam three hours ago with a 196/200.

Ordered this book due to the high reviews. This book is only ok, but I don't think it's really worth purchasing for the cost. I just passed my test an hour ago (got a score of 193) and I can say this book really was not all that helpful with regards to what's on the test. All it does is provide a simple and general review of what each credit is, nothing more and nothing less. It does make it easier to understand the purpose of the credit, but that's it. Overall the book is too simple and too general. In all honesty, you could easily find the same information for free online elsewhere (I found some free videos which did a much better job at explaining things). There are many things on the test that this book does not really cover in depth enough.

I passed! Use this book. All I did was read this book and only this book about 4 times over 10 days, took some notes in the book, and concentrated on memorizing the info. As for myself, I have been exposed in the past to some green building principals so I had some foundation, but even if I hadn't I'm confident this book will definitely prepare you enough to pass. It's easy to read, plenty of space for notes, highlights important info, content well organized.

Gang Chen's book is very comprehensive. It covers all the information for the LEED GA exam, maybe more than the actual exam material. Please follow through with the book, it is written to be strategic study material, so don't undermine his directions on how to study for the actual exam. Dissolve and read it over and over again.

Total rip-off! I paid \$48 for this so-called exam guide and all I got was a bunch of words that didn't make any sense! If it wasn't for another exam preparation material I found 3 days before the test, not only I would have failed on the exam, but also I would be too confused about the basics of green building! LEED and green building knowledge is more of a common sense... for the exam purposes you need to know a couple of rules and standards not a bunch of unrelated stuff and details on how many points you'll earn!!!

I honestly don't know how this book is getting so many 5 star reviews. It provides a good overview of the Green Associate exam but is so general that you don't really learn anything. If you're new to green building, you won't be able to pass the exam using just this book, so what's the point in purchasing it? If you're not new to green building, then this book won't be helpful because it'll just be a review of everything you already know. I studied this book for weeks and still failed multiple

practice exams. Save your money and try something else.

It includes information that do not concern the LEED Green Associate Exam, and lacks other key subjects. It is not useful, in fact, most of the book is a copy paste of information available for free at USGBC website.

This guide is already out of date and missing information. I bought this and a study guide and between the both of them I got a 90%, but this book and the other study guide are already behind and missing new standards and information. This guide alone should be able to get you a passing grade.
