

I ran into this Straight A's book after finishing my pediatrics class. I wish I had discovered it sooner! It provides material in outline form, getting rid of the excess verbosity. It also puts important concepts in the margin of the book, so you can quickly get the essential ideas. In addition, everything was in sync with my lecture notes. So not only is it a good summary, but it also summarizes the right things. I compared this book with the similar Lippincott Review Series book, and this was the better of the two.

and makes it so much easier to understand. It helped me get through nursing level II. The CD has Nclex type questions which are also very helpful.

First off this is a great book used in conjunction to materials from a pediatrics course. It does an excellent job condensing material and making the important points clear. My only downside, which is rather frustrating, is that the CD in the back of the book with all the NCLEX questions does not work on MAC computers.

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
